The Town of North Greenbush and its consulting engineering team of Creighton Manning and Laberge Group Engineering will conduct a public information meeting on Tuesday, June 5th, 2018 at 6:30 pm at the North Greenbush Fire District #1 Offices located at 350 North Greenbush Road, Troy, New York to review the draft preliminary design and encourage public input for future US Route 4 Corridor intersection construction safety improvements for vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

The Town received funding through the New York State Department of Transportation from the Consolidated Appropriations Act to cover 80% of the project costs. Including the Town share, the budget for this project is \$9.829 million to improve traffic and pedestrian safety along the Route 4 Corridor at the intersections of Bloomingrove Drive, Valley View Blvd., Winter Street Extension and Williams/Glenmore Road, as well as and points between these intersections. Construction is expected to begin in 2019.

This public information meeting is intended to encourage public input into this Route 4 Corridor transportation project from individuals, businesses, and local groups and agencies. Any suggestions and or comments made at the meeting will be considered by the project team as the project is progressed.
