The Town of North Greenbush and its consulting engineering team of Creighton Manning and Laberge Group Engineering will conduct a second public information meeting on Wednesday, March 13th, 2019 at 6:00 pm at the Defreestville Fire Department located at 350 North Greenbush Road (Route 4), Troy, New York to review the proposed final design report and encourage public input for the US Route 4 Corridor intersection construction safety improvements for vehicular and pedestrian traffic.

The Town received funding through the New York State Department of Transportation from the Consolidated Appropriations Act to cover 80% of the project costs. Including the Town share, the budget for this project is \$9.829 million to improve traffic and pedestrian safety along the Route 4 Corridor at the intersections of Bloomingrove Drive, Valley View Blvd., Winter Street Extension and Williams/Glenmore Road, as well as and points between these intersections. Construction is expected to begin later this year.
